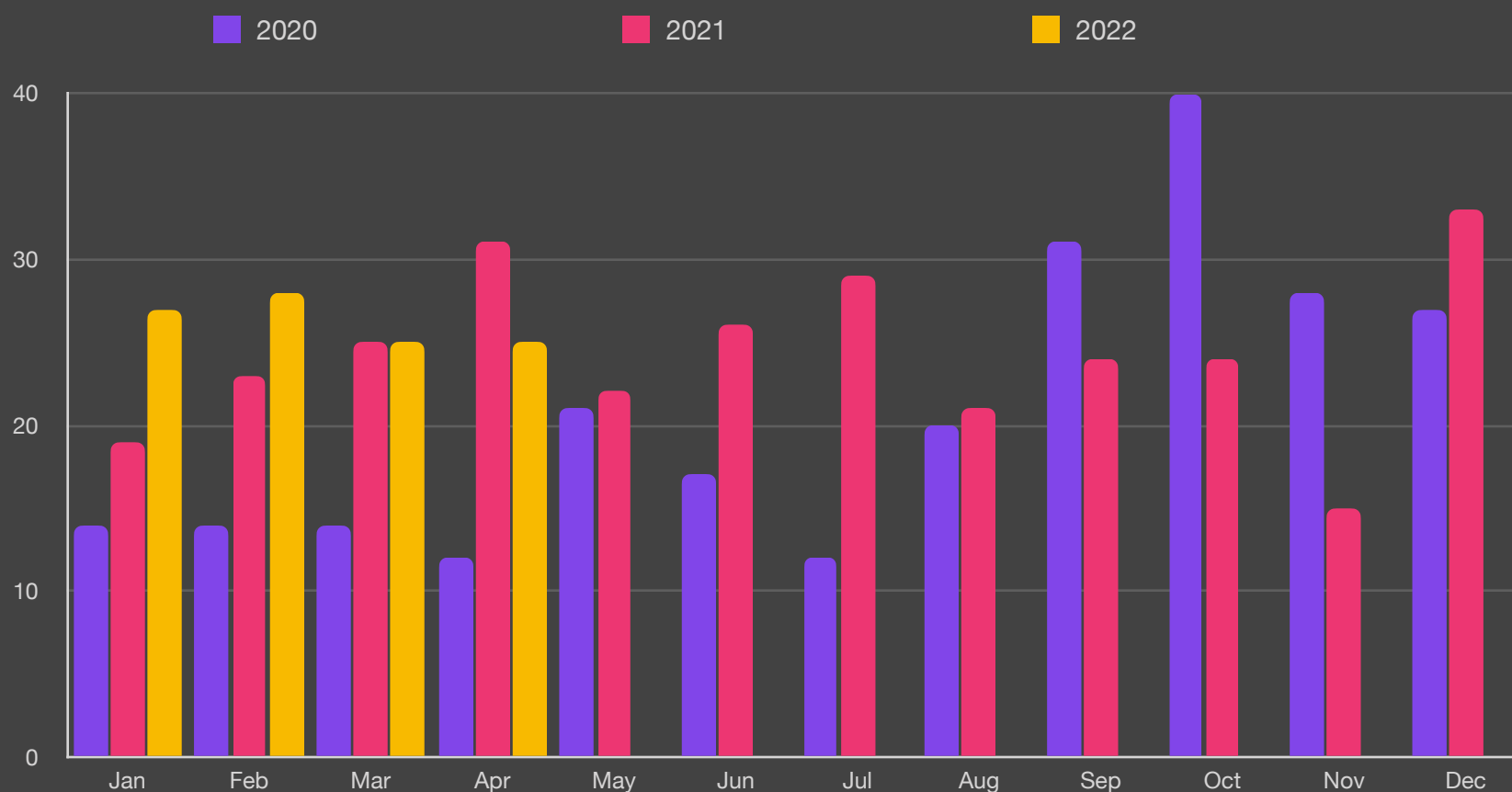


April 2022

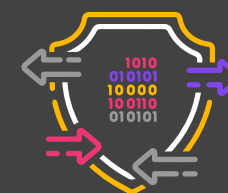
Ransomware Trend by Month

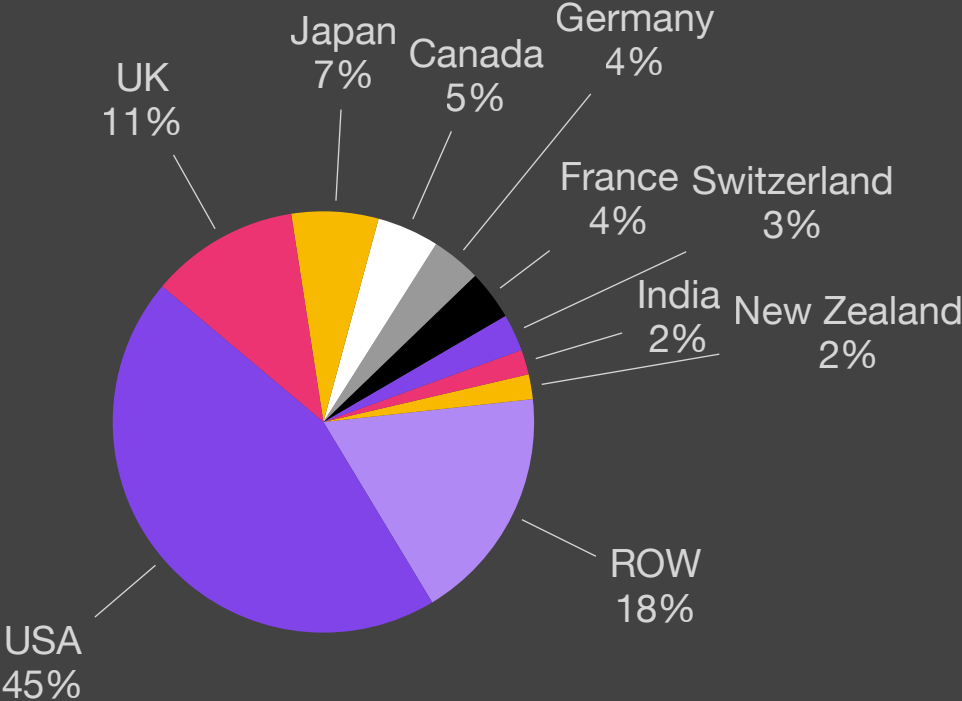

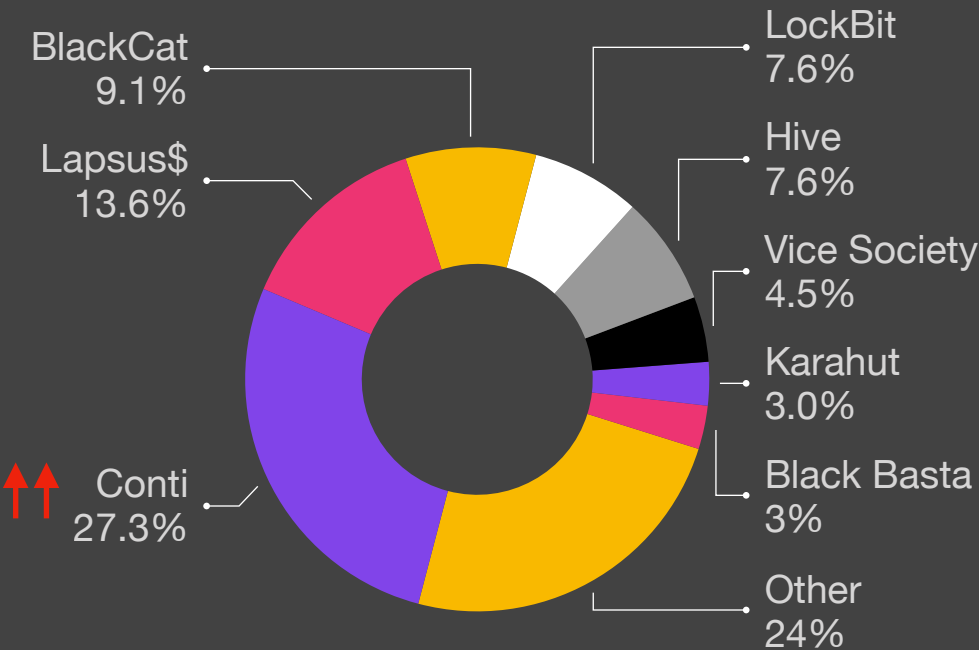

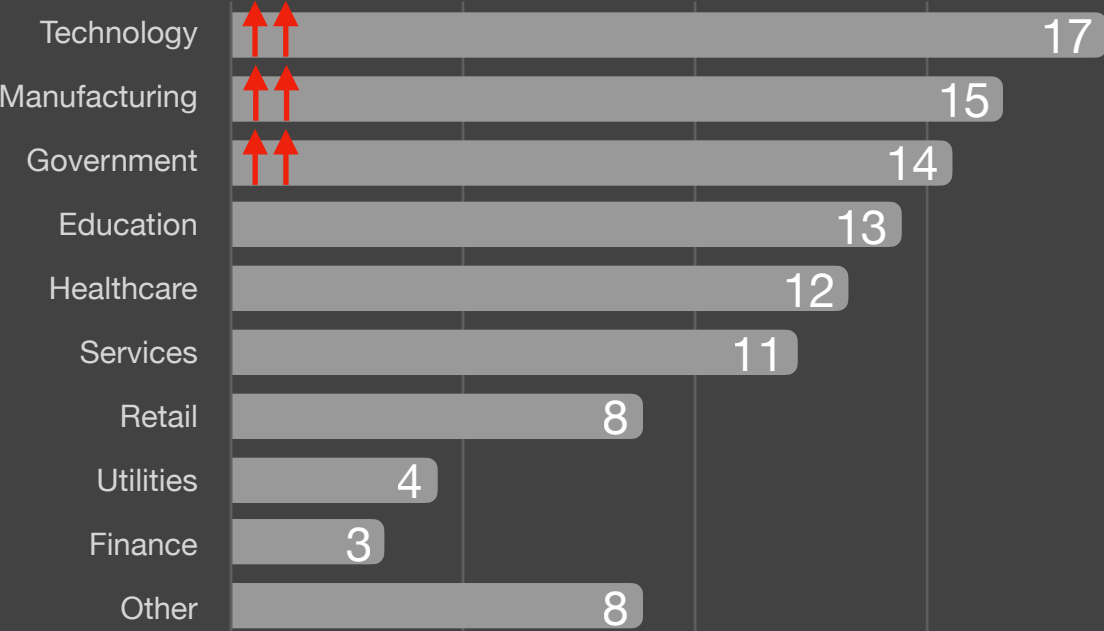
Ransomware by Country



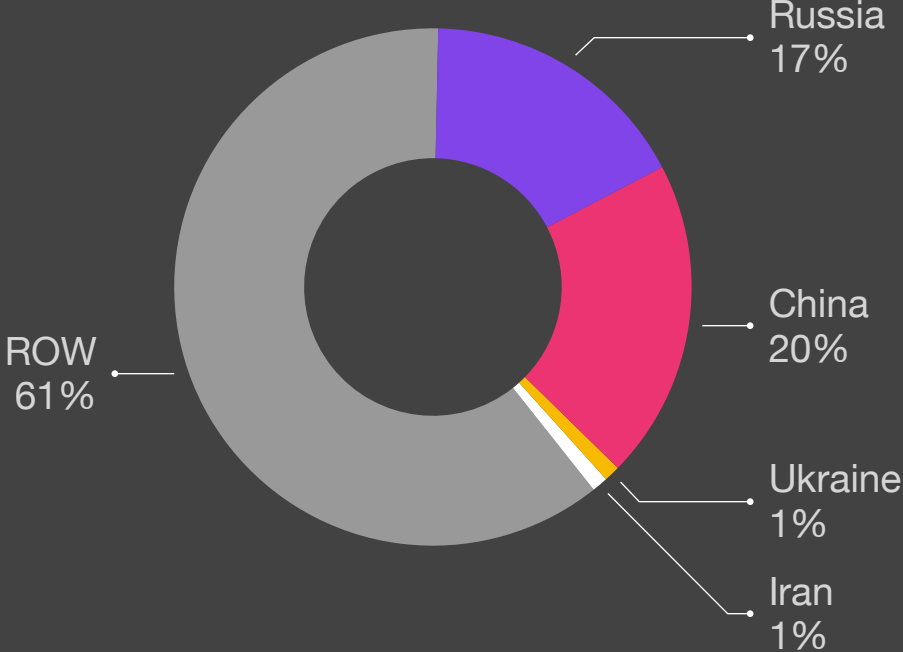
Ransomware by Variant



Ransomware by Industry

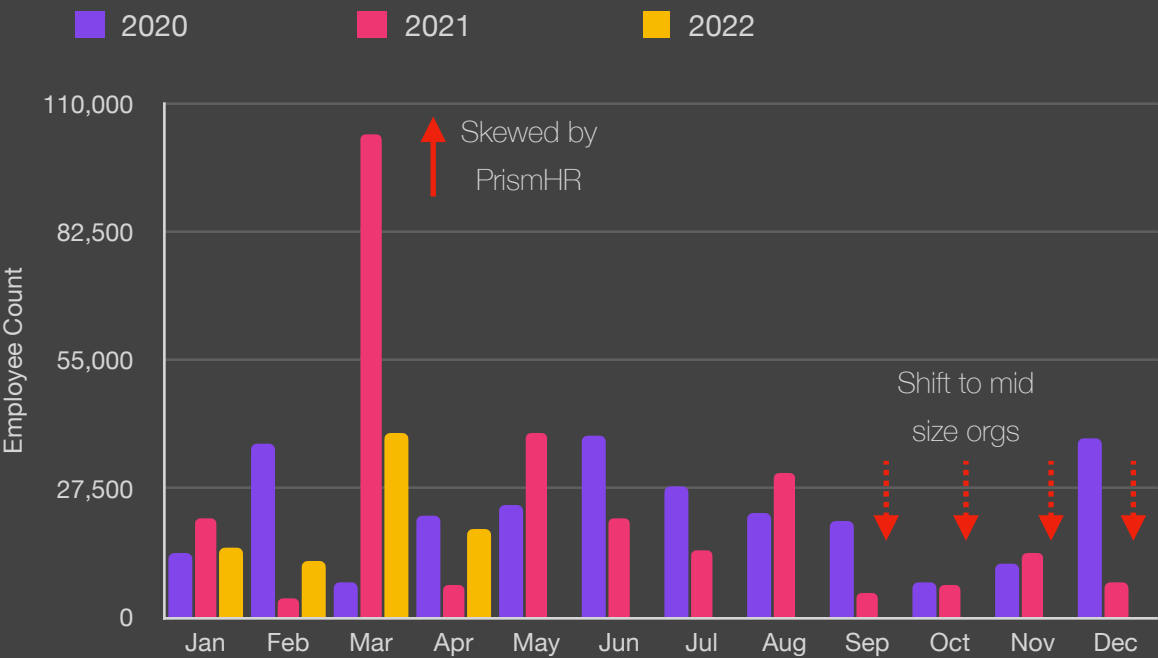


Ransomware Exfiltration Country

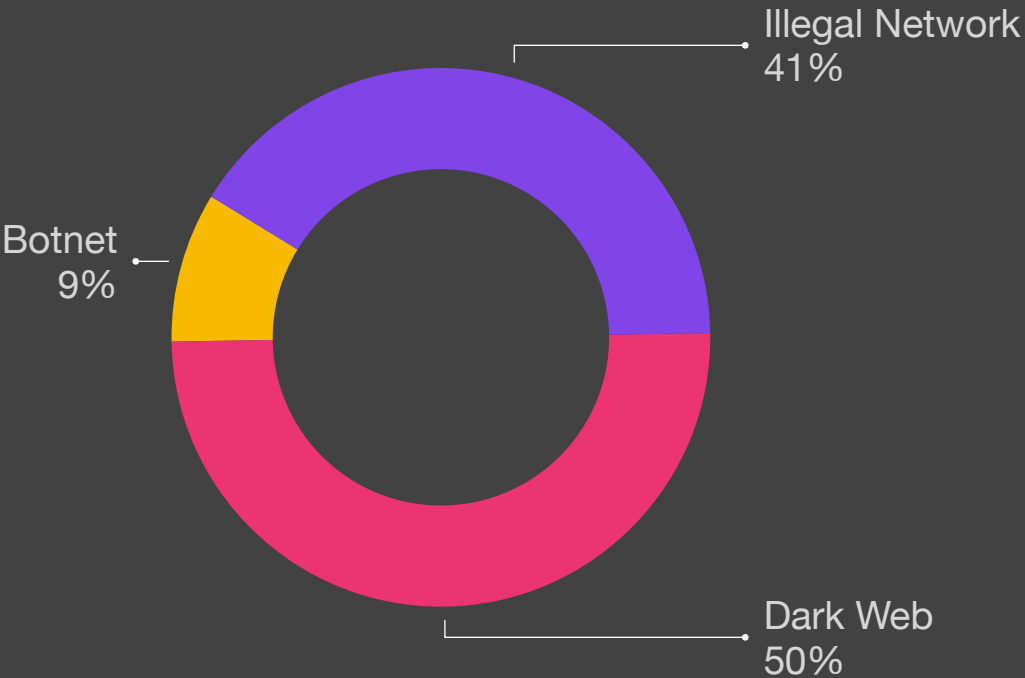




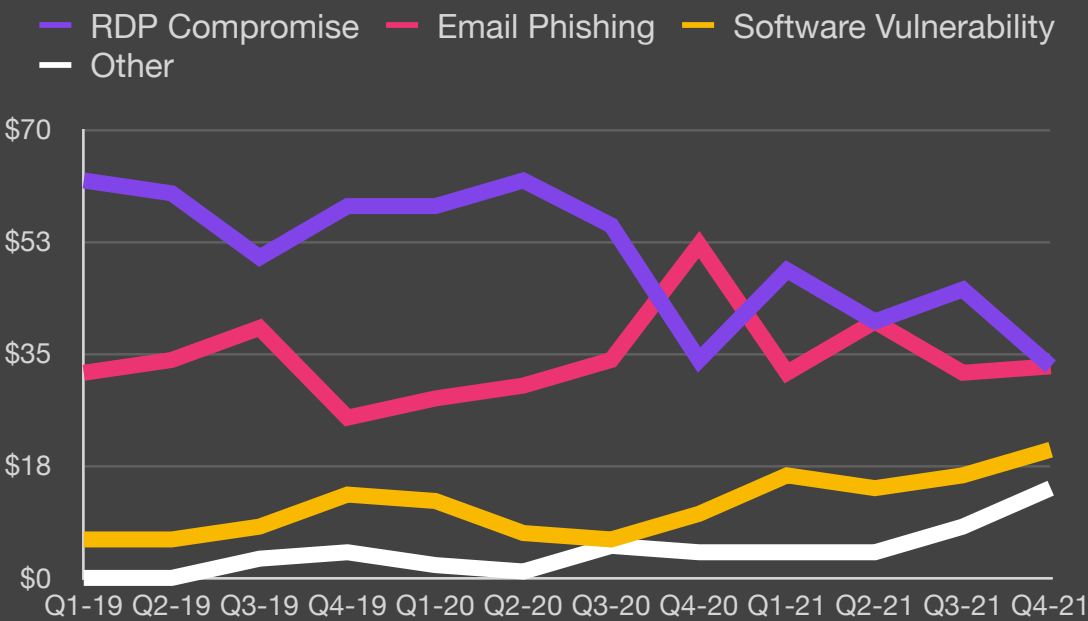
Size of Organization

Methodology
